

How to find us - Concise Guide

Whether you are coming from somewhere in Harrogate or from afar, getting to St Mark's Church is really easy! Zoom and pan on the map below (using the arrows) to get your bearings or click on the map marker for directions from anywhere.

Alternatively, put our postcode into your Sat Nav and let your car find it's own way! HG2 8AY.

On foot

From the Town Centre (Betty's Tea Shop)

Walk south (against the one-way traffic flow) for one mile along the A61. After the Prince of Wales roundabout, the road crosses the Stray (the big green bit!) and then the St Georges roundabout. St Mark's is immediately on your left.

From the Town Centre (Rail & Bus Terminal) Walk south (with the one-way traffic flow) for ½ mile; bear right diagonally across the Stray; bear left onto the A61 Leeds Road; cross the St Georges roundabout; St Mark's is immediately on your left. By car

From the South (Leeds, Bradford, Otley)

At the Harrogate ring-road roundabout, take the A61 north to Harrogate; through the first traffic lights (car showroom on right); St Mark's is on the right after ¾ mile (just before the first roundabout).

From the South (Wetherby, York)

At the Harrogate ring-road roundabout, take the A661 north into Harrogate; left at the second traffic lights (Woodlands Pub on left); right at 3rd traffic lights; St Mark's is on the right after ¾ mile (immediately before the first roundabout).

From the North (Ripon)

Follow A61 through Harrogate towards Leeds; leaving the town-centre, St Mark's is on the left after the Stray, just beyond the St George's roundabout.

From the East (Knaresborough)

Follow A59 towards Harrogate; straight across the Empress roundabout; along York Place; left at the Prince of Wales roundabout towards Leeds; St Mark's is on the left after the Stray, just beyond the St George's roundabout.
